


Women in Fund Finance was created in 2017 by the alternative industry association, the Fund Finance Association, to support diversity and the participation of women in the private equity/alternatives space within banking, law, sponsors/asset managers, investors and supporting industry providers. Women in Fund Finance (WFF) is led globally by three committees of senior women executives in the US, EMEA and APAC, and is focused on increased engagement, recognition and promotion of women leaders within the fund finance industry globally. We seek to help women succeed in three ways: **connection, education and professional advocacy.**

2023 WFF In Review

Women in Fund Finance distributes its event information to over 5,200 contacts globally, and hosts events across North America, EMEA and APAC regions. WFF EMEA have recently expanded to cover the EMEA area more widely with events in Paris and Luxembourg, with more events to come in local centre. WFF APAC has also expanded to host events in Sydney, Singapore and Hong Kong. WFF US have hosted events this year in New York, Charlotte, Chicago and L.A, and are continuing to plan more events in these cities, as well as Dallas and Boston.


WFF US: ESG Strategies in a CRE Downturn **WFF EMEA:** Networking Gathering in London
